SMALL SPACE CHALLENGE

Many kids room are very small and parents usually find it very difficult to decorate.

How do you make space for furniture, clothes, toys and area to play and be creative, while still having a beautiful and organized kids room?

There are many solutions and this guide will help you find the perfect one for you. .

INTERIOR FOR THE YOUNGER CHILD:

CONSIDERATIONS BEFORE BEGINNING:

- What are the needs and the important functions of the room?
- Make a mood board with ideas and wishes.
- What could be placed in other rooms of the house?
- Consider getting a custom made bedroom that will last until their teenage years.

MUSTS AND DON'TS:

- It is very important with good and organized storage.
- Use the whole room.
- Encourage your child to keep the room tidy.
- Floor space to tumble and play on.
- Don't use heavy curtains.

SUGGESTIONS:

- Colors: Light and neutral colors will create a calm and peaceful space. Try not to use many different colors, but choose different tones of the same color.
- Make a focus wall, by painting a wall or by using wallpaper.
- Use wall stickers. They can easily be changed.
- Good lightning, to create different moods.
- Use the walls height, under the bed, above closets, and in between furniture for storage.
- Place pictures or illustrations on the storage, so the child knows what goes in it.
- Use beautiful storage that is decorative.
- Have a small table on the wall that fold down.



HOW TO USE OTHER AREAS OF THE HOUSE:

- Place the play kitchen in the kitchen or living room.
- Choose a shelf or drawer in the living room, for all their creative materials.
- Make a play area in the living room, kids love to play where you are. If you don't have space, then just have a basket with toys.

INTERIOR FOR THE OLDER KIDS:

CONSIDERATIONS BEFORE BEGINNING:

- What is important for your kid?
- Which existing furniture and decoration has to stay in the room.
- Make a mood board with ideas and wishes.

- It is very important with good and organized storage.
- Use the whole room.
- Don't use heavy curtains.

SUGGESTIONS:

- Color: Use white as the base color. That will create a calm background, where bright and strong colors on the furniture and decorative items, can bring life the room.
- Make a focus wall, by painting a wall or by using wallpaper.
- Use wall stickers. They can easily be changed.
- Make space for friends sleeping over.
- Night lamp on the wall.
- Good lightning, to create different moods.
- Good workspace for homework and creativity.
- Decorate the bed with a beautiful bedcover.
- Use the walls height, under the bed, above closets, and in between furniture for storage.
- Use beautiful storage that is decorative.
- Choose a stool as nightstand. It can be used when your child has guest over.
- Instead of a desk chair, choose a smaller chair or stool.



THE CREATIVE SOLUTIONS:

- If there is high to the ceiling, then use the space with a high loft bed, or get a custom made, that is build as part of the room.

- Place desk area under the bed.
- Build/place a bed above drawers or bookcases. Part of the bed might need to have support on the wall. There can also be place behind the drawers/bookcases, for a choosy play cave, which can be decorated with pillows, wallpaper and fairy lights.

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
